



A duct connector with damper is provided inside the hood.

Position the damper axle "A" in the loop under the damper lid; see Fig. 2. Ensure that the clips "B" engage under the edge of the plate. Press the connector into position until the snap locks is fixed.







Press once. Damper remains open for 30 mins.

Press twice. Damper remains open for 60 mins.

Press three times: Damper remains open for 90 mins.

Press again. Damper closes.

The damper closes automatically after 30/60/90 minutes and the ventilation unit returns to normal ventilation, speed 2.

B. Lighting

Open the damper while cooking. Adjust the speed of the ventilation unit's fans depending on the type of food you are cooking. It is a good idea to open the damper a short while before and after cooking, in order to avoid the spread of odours in the room.

3.2. CARE AND MAINTENANCE

3.2.1. CLEANING

The cooker hood should be cleaned with a damp cloth and washing-up liquid. The filter must be cleaned approximately twice a month, with normal usage.

Remove the filter cassette by pressing on the clips on the front edge. Dismantle the filter cartridge and remove the filter cloth by loosening the retainer, Fig. 6. Squeeze the filter cloth in warm water mixed with washing-up liquid. The filter cassette (with filter) can also be washed in the dishwasher. The interior of the cooker hood should also be cleaned a few times a year. Wipe the interior with
